The Management of Bandari College (BC) wishes to inform all Graduands of Basic Technician Certificate (NTA Level 4) and Ordinary Diploma (NTA Level 6) for the Academic Year 2019/2020 that, following completion of 21 days for national mourning, the Graduation Ceremony that was postponed will now be held on **Saturday, 17th April, 2021. The Ceremony will start from 9:00 am at the College's Campus**, along Mahunda Street, near Mwembeyanga – Tandika, Dar es Salaam.

Since this is an important event, you are advised to attend and witness the pinnacle of your academic pursuit at Bandari College Dar es Salaam.

GRADUANDS ARE REQUIRED TO OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING:

1. Graduands who intend to participate in the Ceremony are required to confirm their participation by sending message through phone number 0658 782 843 or email to pbcc@ports.go.tz **NOT later than Thursday, 15th April, 2021**
2. Participants will pay a non-refundable amount of Tshs. 20,000/= only as a cost for hiring graduation gown. The money shall be paid through the Government e-Payment Gateway (GePG) system where the Control Number is obtained from the Bursar's Office at the College not later than **Friday, 16th April, 2021**. A payment receipt should be submitted to the College Bursars' Office for registration. The collection of graduation gowns will take place on **Friday, 16th April, 2021**.
3. The hired gowns shall be returned to the College from 19th April to 23rd April, 2021. Any gown not returned on time will attract a penalty of TZS 10,000 per day for the period of delay.
4. Graduands should report at the College's Campus for **rehearsal on Friday, 16th April, 2021 from 10:00 am**. Only the names of the candidates appearing on the Graduation Guide Book shall be conferred by the Guest of Honour during the Ceremony.
5. All participants are expected to bear the costs of transport and upkeep in Dar es Salaam.
