ii) Medical Expenses (NHIF)

This is compulsory to all students. Health insurance cards will be provided to each student after paying the NIF contribution of Tshs. 50,400. This contribution will be paid through a separate control number obtained from the NHIF website. Students will be guided how to get control number during registration. Students with valid Health Insurance Cards already need not to pay the above

contribution instead should submit copies of their card(s) during registration for verification.

iv) Registration Requirements

The reporting date to the College is **Monday**, **09**th **October 2023**. The registration period is strictly two weeks from the opening day whereby the first week (**09**th - **13**rd **October 2023**) is scheduled for registration and the second week (**16**th -**20**th **October 2023**) for orientation. Failure to comply will result to **losing your chance**. To qualify for the registration, a student must fulfil the following requirements:

- a) Pay the applicable tuition fees and other contributions.
- b) Present all **original** Academic Certificates and birth certificate for verification process and submit a set of its copies (i.e. Form IV, VI, NTA Level 4, Birth Certificate, or any applicable certificate).
- c) Bring two photographs (stamp size).
- d) Submit personally dully filled Medical Examination Report (Form D). See the attachment.
- e) Residence Permit (for foreigners).

All students (new and continuing) shall be required to register every semester to validate their studentship. The normal registration period is two weeks from the opening date of an academic semester.

3. ACCOMMODATION

The College does not offer accommodation. Students are advised to make their own arrangements for accommodation in advance prior to commencement of studies. Foreigners selected to join to the College for any programme may consult admission office for guidance on accommodation.

4. RULES AND REGULATIONS

Students admitted into the College are expected to abide to the rules and regulations governing the College. Failure to observe or comply with College rules and regulations

may lead to disciplinary action. Among the disciplinary offence led to dismissal from studies are:

- i. To instigate or participate in any mob action, strike, the boycott of classes.
- ii. Rape or indecent assault.
- iii. Forging a document or uttering a false document or perpetrating forgery with intent to cause loss to any person, College, or any other institution whether in cash or otherwise.
- iv. Unauthorized possession and/or use of any dangerous weapon both within and outside the College.
- v. To keep in possession any kind of illegal drugs and, or engage in any business or transaction which involves illegal drugs
- vi. Theft committed within the College; for avoidance of doubt, where a student is charged with and convicted of theft under the Law, the College may take disciplinary measures against such a student notwithstanding that he/she is prosecuted and or punished by a court of law.
- vii. Mismanagement and /or embezzlement of Students' Organisation funds and/or of any other recognized student society established under the auspices of the Students' Organisation in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Student's Organisation's constitution for the time being in force.
- viii. Convicted for a criminal offence or moral turpitude.

5. COMMUNICATION

Students are required to regularly consult notice boards, Student Information Management System (SIMS), College Website www.bandari.ac.tz and personnel from the Registrar's Office.

6. PORT VISIT AND STUDY

For the purpose of port visit as part of the study all students are required to buy the following:

- i) High Visibility Vest (Reflector)
- ii) Safety Shoes
- iii) Safety Helmets

7. DRESSING CODE

Every student should use appropriate dress code and conduct to be observed by all students at the College when on the College's premises or when attending any official functions organized by College or in which the College is involved (See the attached samples).

8. IMPORTANT NOTICE:

- i) One semester is equivalent to 17 weeks
- ii) Field attachment is an integral part of each training programme offered at the College. Sponsors/Parents are requested to support students during this period by paying allowances to students to meet field expenses. The duration of the attachment is not less than 4 weeks.
- iii) Fee once paid is not refundable.
- iv) The College reserves the right to change fees payable to itself as deemed fit or on a short notice
- v) Money for private use/incidental expenses should not be deposited into the College's bank account by parents or sponsors.
- vi) A student is required to wear the Identification Card (ID) throughout within the College premises. Loss of ID shall imply re-payment to the College of processing fee Tshs. 10,000 after submission of police loss report for ID re-printing. Students who will repeat (a year/module) or resume studies after postponement should also re-pay the ID fee.
